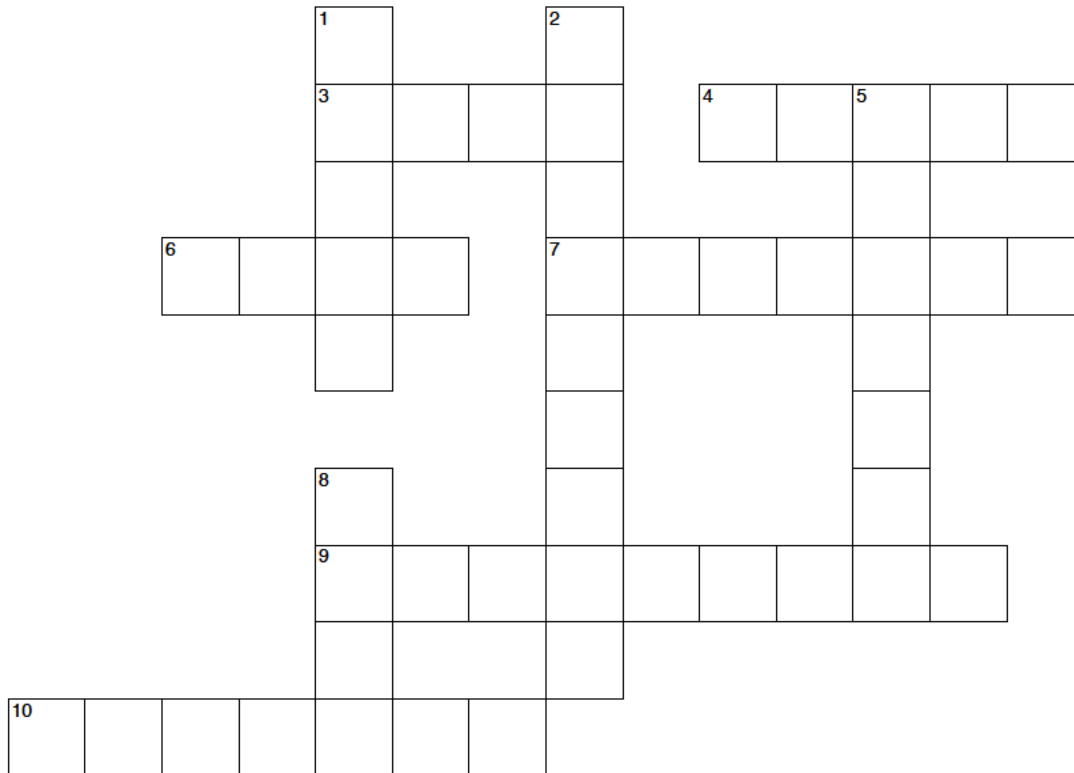


Better Than the Rest

- 4 higher than or on top of
- 6 to move upward
- 7 earning points
- 9 very wonderful
- 10 someone who uses brushes and paint to make pictures called paintings

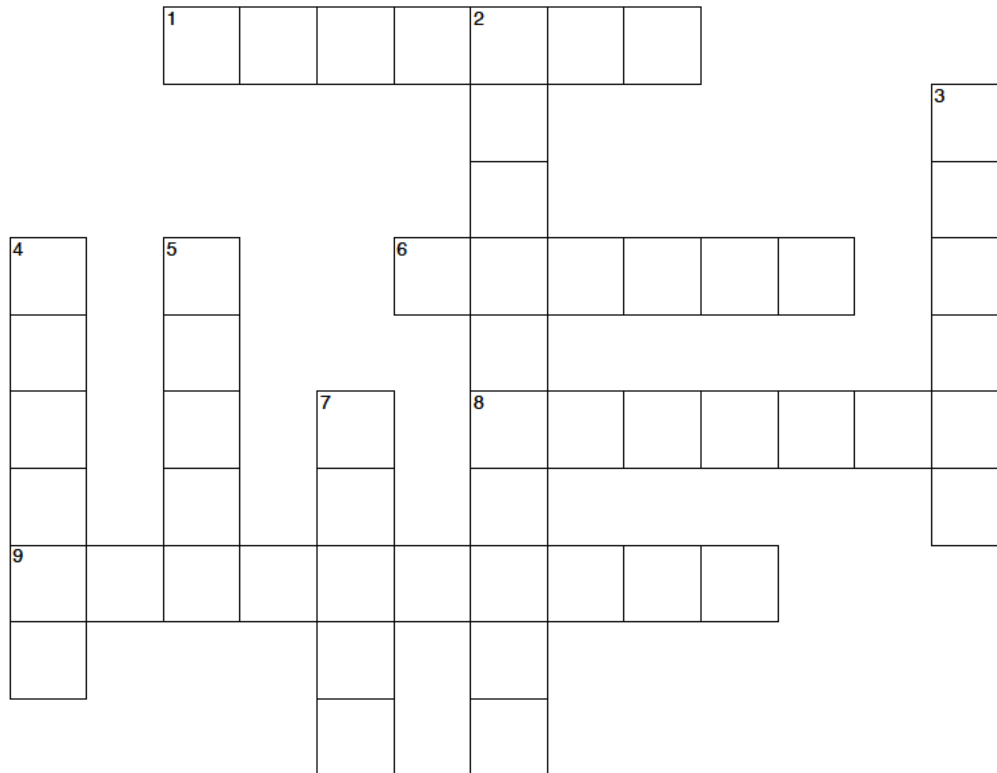
DOWN

- 1 uncooked, unprocessed, or without anything added
- 2 talked in a very soft voice
- 5 what a person thinks about something
- 8 the others who make up a group

WORD BANK: above, excellent, fresh, opinion, painter, rest, rich, rise, scoring, whispered

ACROSS

- 1** a job or task that usually has several parts and needs planning
- 6** to become very cold or turn to ice
- 8** the study of nature and the way that things are in the universe
- 9** the things that are happening at certain moments

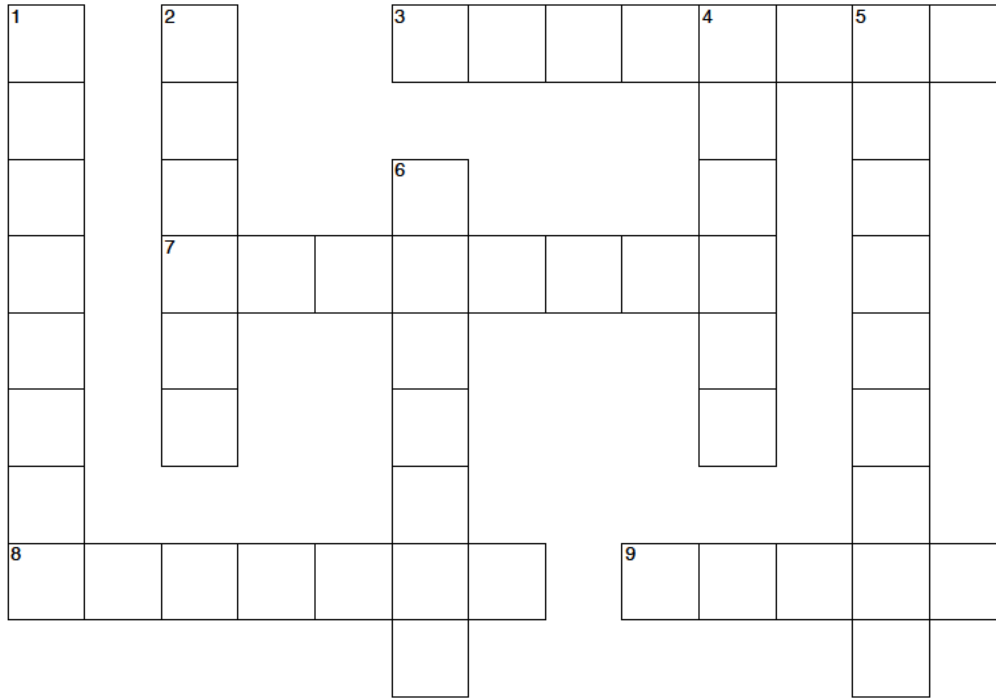
DOWN

- 2** a well-known group of words that means something specific
- 3** the colorful part of a plant that has seeds
- 4** to get to the end or to complete
- 5** to do something because of something else that has happened
- 7** ways of doing things that you have thought about ahead of time

WORD BANK: expression, finish, flower, freeze, plans, project, react, science, situations

ACROSS

- 3 gave a penalty to someone for doing something wrong
- 7 most liked or best loved
- 8 said something very loudly
- 9 mad or unhappy

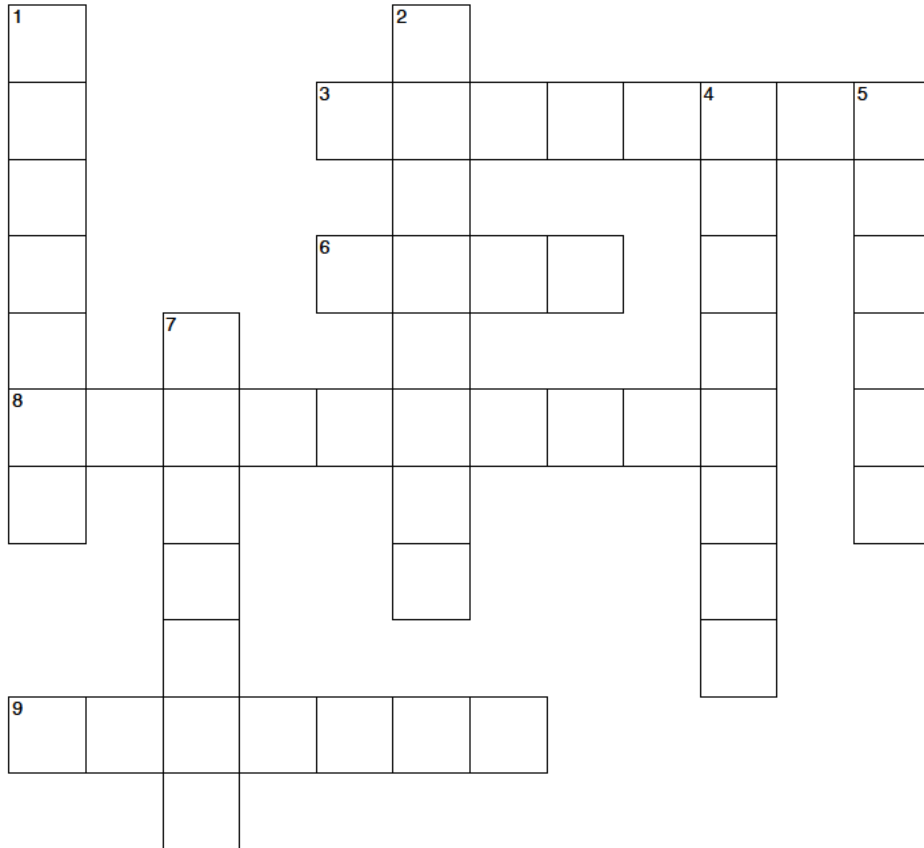
DOWN

- 1 do not pay attention and make mistakes
- 2 the time at which someone is expected to be home
- 4 to yell or screech
- 5 told how or why or gave more information
- 6 feeling afraid that something bad will happen

WORD BANK: careless, curfew, explained, favorite, punished, scream, shouted, upset, worried

In Love

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 having to do with the love of someone you date or are married to, or someone you want to date or marry
- 6 made something go somewhere
- 8 showing care and kindness
- 9 acted or behaved toward someone in a certain way

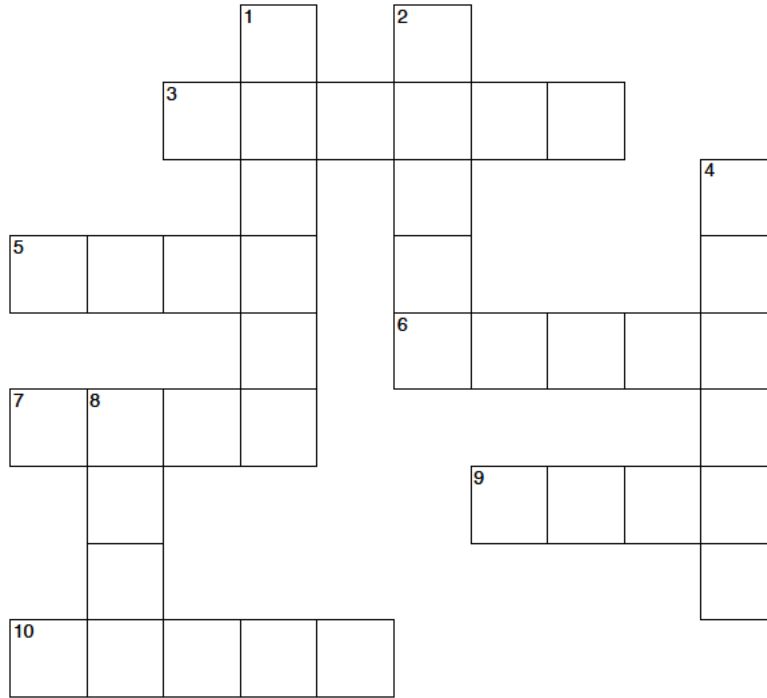
DOWN

- 1 a person or persons belonging to the king's or queen's family
- 2 with each other or with other people
- 4 very happy and excited
- 5 a small number of something, usually two
- 7 people who do things together in groups of two

WORD BANK: couple, couples, romantic, royalty, sent, thoughtful, thrilled, together, treated

Just Right

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 cutting a large area of grass or plants with a machine called a lawn mower
- 5 the area of grass around a house or building
- 6 a thin piece cut from something bigger
- 7 something you must have
- 9 something you would like to have
- 10 a food people eat between meals

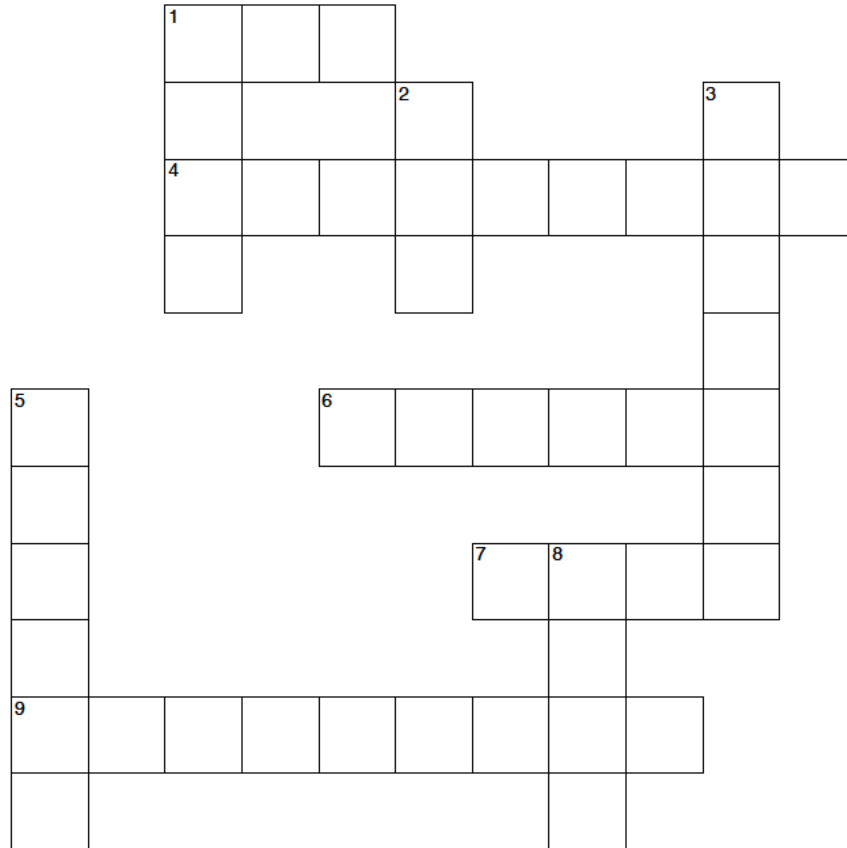
DOWN

- 1 drank all of something very quickly
- 2 supplies or gives what is needed
- 4 more than enough
- 8 to get something because you worked for it

WORD BANK: downed, earn, fills, lawn, mowing, need, plenty, slice, snack, want

ACROSS

- 1 came together
- 4 planned
- 6 to move around quickly
- 7 an informal name for a group of two or more people
- 9 to urge, inspire, or make others want to do something

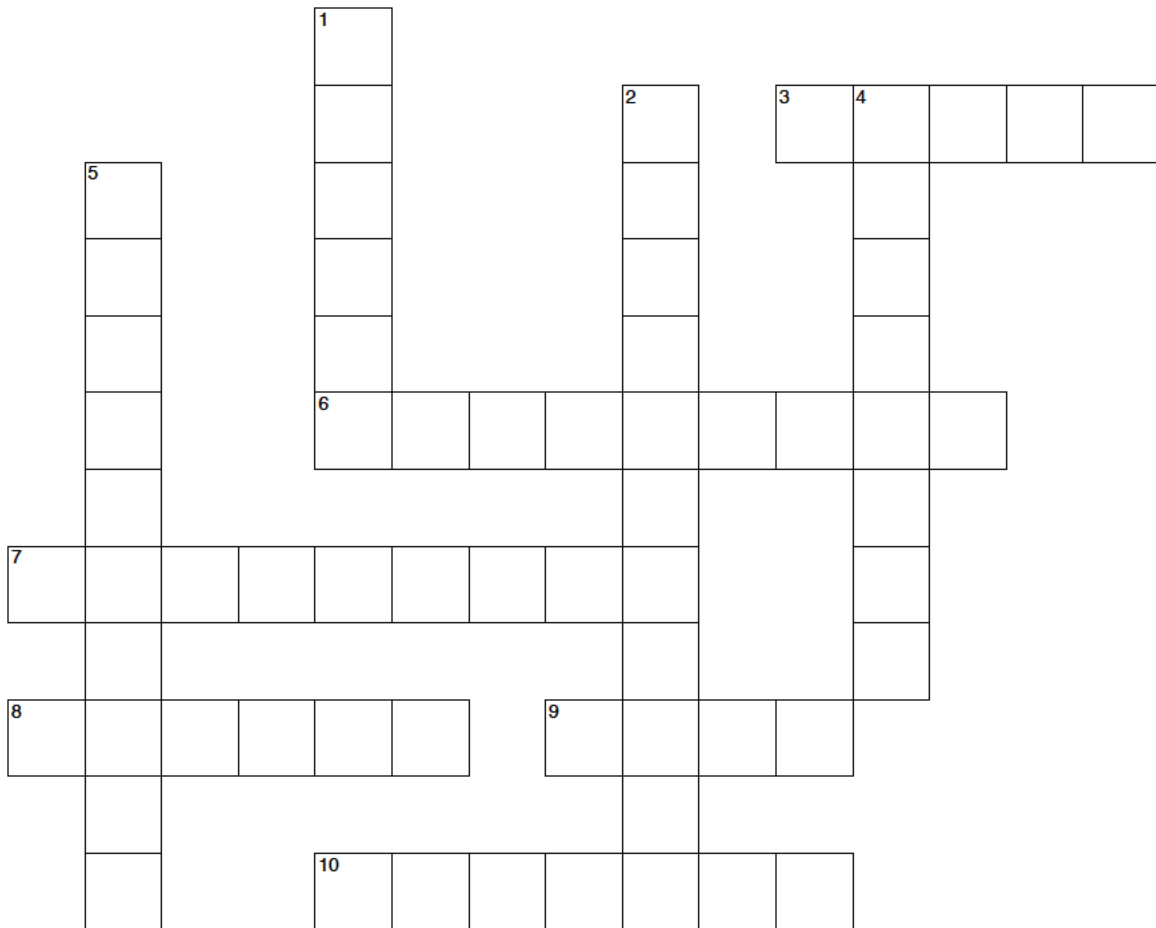
DOWN

- 1 do not get to use something or do something, often because you were too late
- 2 a small number of something
- 3 people who are part of a club, church, political party, or other group
- 5 to take place or to occur
- 8 to ask or encourage someone to do something

WORD BANK: encourage, few, guys, happen, members, met, miss, scheduled, urge, wiggle

Living an Easy Life

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 a spot where you can go or be
- 6 hard, not easy
- 7 the thing that is happening at a certain moment
- 8 more than enough
- 9 ill or not healthy
- 10 a game in which you buy tickets and hope to win a prize, usually a large amount of money

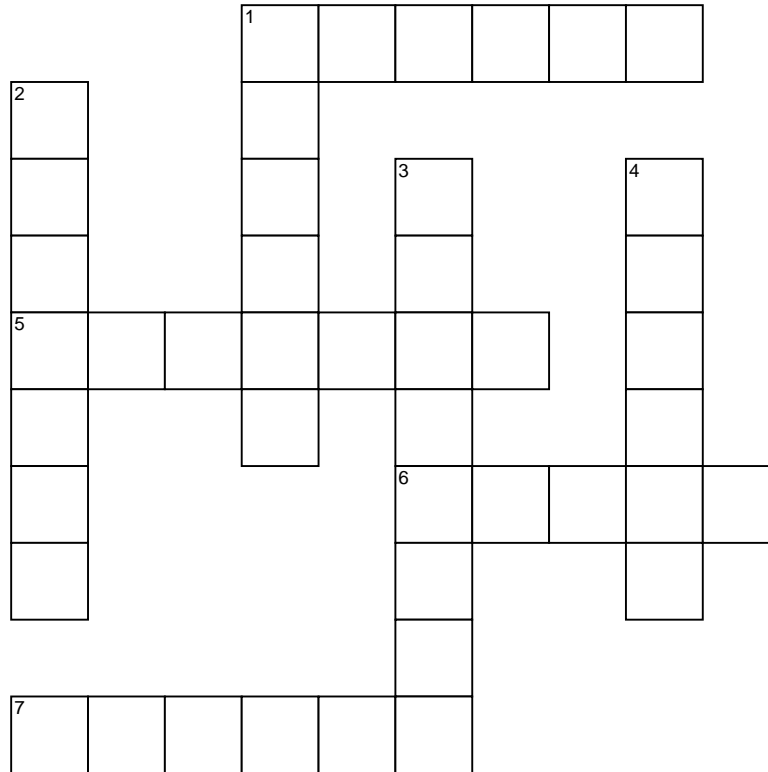
DOWN

- 1 to have the money to pay for something
- 2 someone who has money or property worth at least one million dollars
- 4 someone who owns an apartment, house, or other property, and lets others pay to live there
- 5 in particular or even more so

WORD BANK: afford, difficult, especially, landlord, lottery, millionaire, place, plenty, sick, situation

Love and Marriage

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 1 the season between winter and summer
- 5 mothers or fathers
- 6 many times
- 7 grown-ups or people who are 18 years old and older

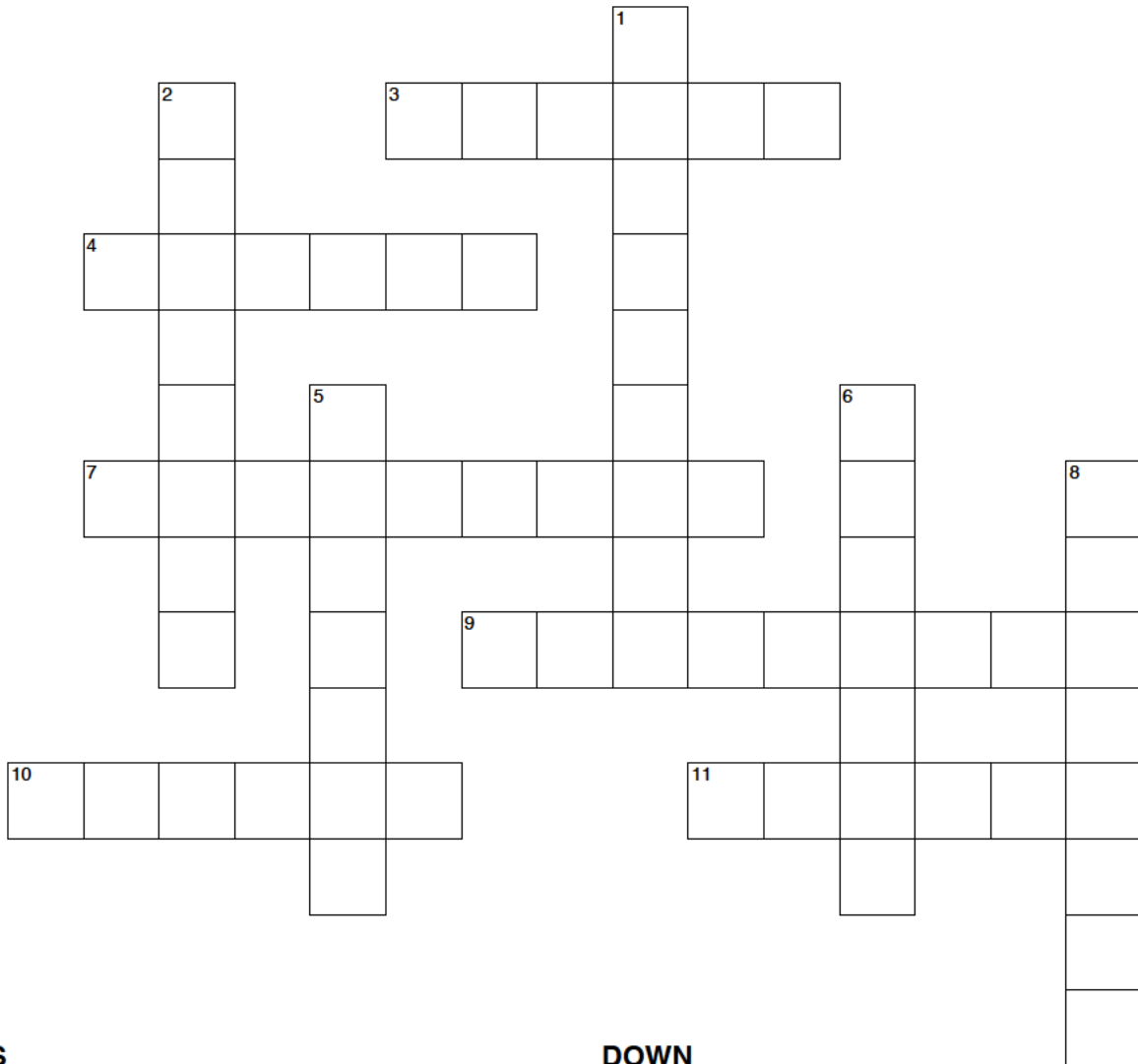
DOWN

- 1 let someone else use or have something of yours
- 2 young dogs
- 3 outside or in the open air
- 4 turned up the corners of your mouth, usually because you were happy

WORD BANK: adults, often, outdoors, parents, puppies, shared, smiled, spring

Something Feels Wrong

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 truthful or doing and saying what is true and right
- 4 a group of words that has a meaning but does not make a sentence
- 7 the thing that is happening at a certain moment
- 9 not telling the truth
- 10 a room where someone works
- 11 nearer to something

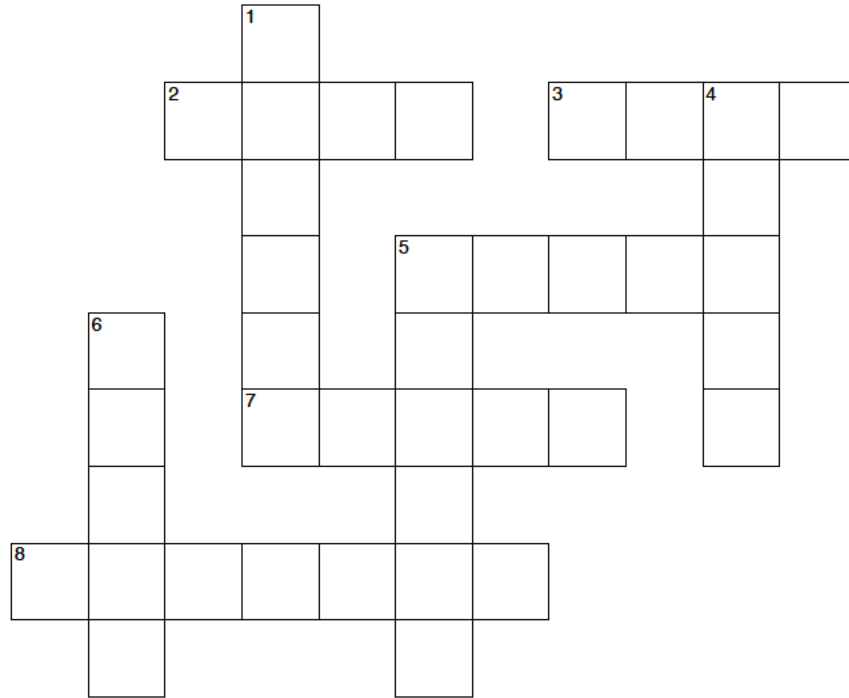
DOWN

- 1 people who live close to you
- 2 the way a person or animal acts
- 5 to have a feeling or belief about something
- 6 what a person thinks about something
- 8 went back to a place

WORD BANK: behavior, closer, dishonest, honest, neighbors, office, opinion, phrase, returned, situation, suspect

Too Much Work!

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 2 with lots of energy
- 3 having many things to do
- 5 to give a score that tells how well something was done
- 7 the period of time that you spend working at a job
- 8 more than two but not many

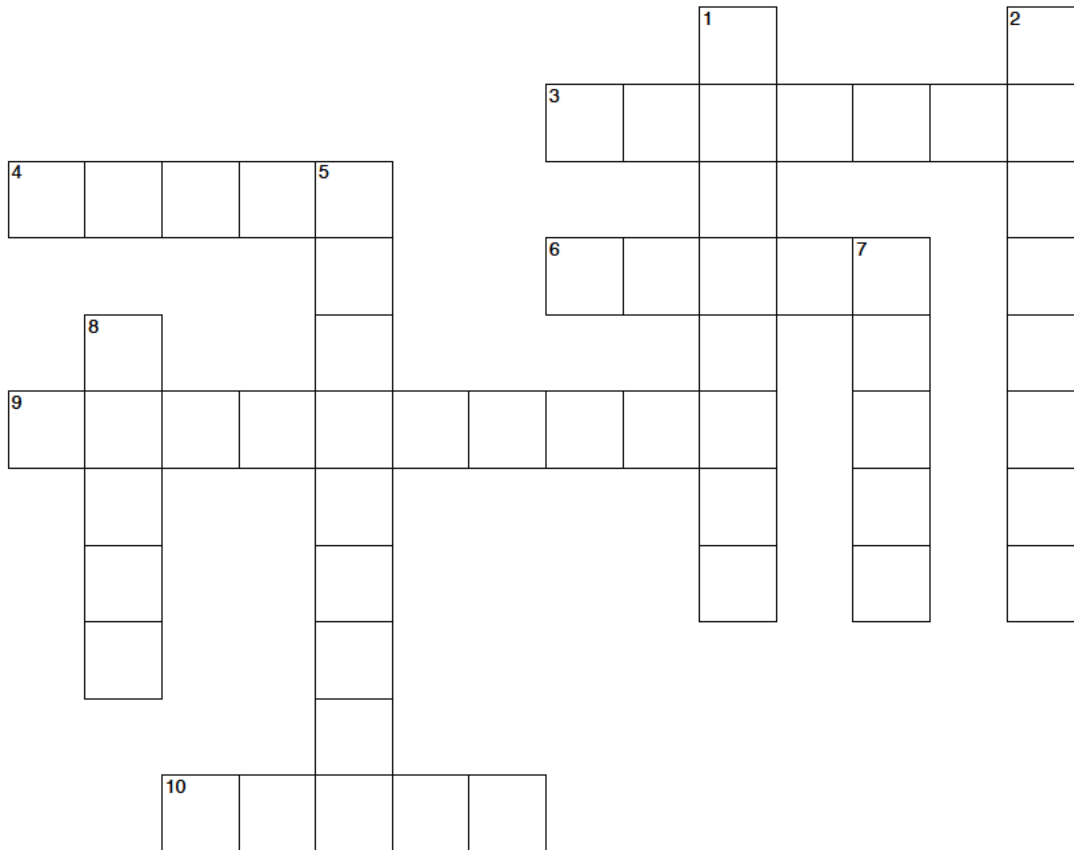
DOWN

- 1 assignments or pages of writing about something
- 4 passed or used up a certain amount of time
- 5 a musical instrument with strings and a long neck played by strumming or plucking
- 6 exhausted or worn out

WORD BANK: busy, grade, guitar, hard, papers, several, shift, spent, tired

What's the Price?

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 something that costs less than it normally would
- 4 how much something costs or the value or worth of something
- 6 has a certain price
- 9 a set of things that are the same in some way
- 10 a piece of clothing

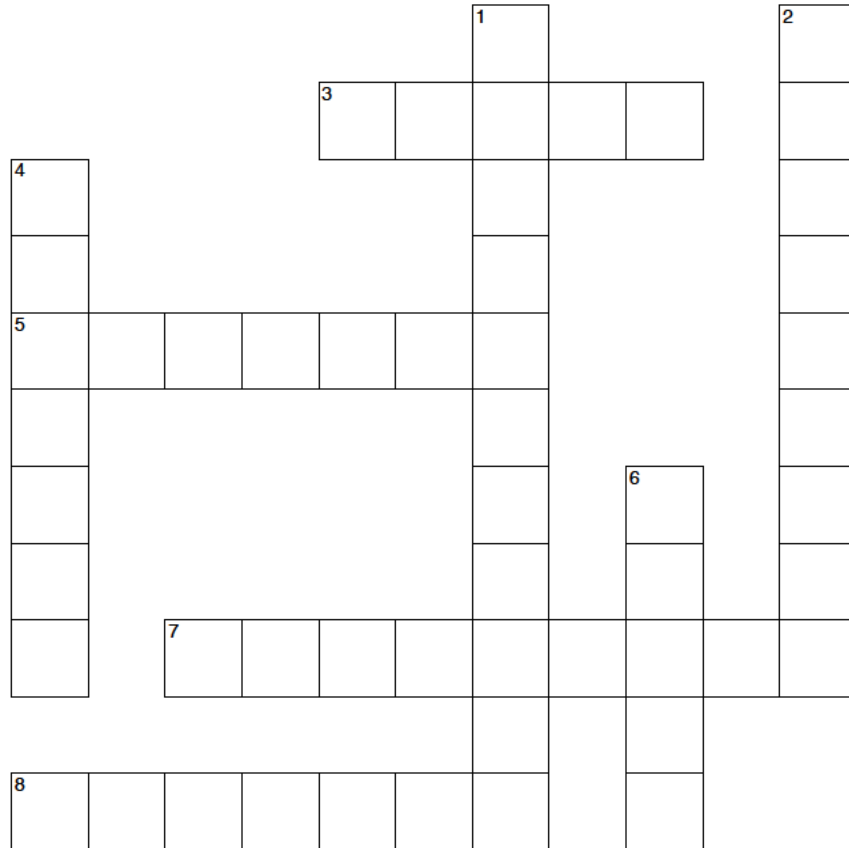
DOWN

- 1 gifts or things given to people
- 2 not expected to happen
- 5 costing a lot of money
- 7 to use money to buy something
- 8 a period of time lasting from 28 days to 31 days

WORD BANK: bargain, collection, costs, dress, expensive, month, presents, price, spend, unlikely

What's Wrong?

Idioms, Level 3.0



ACROSS

- 3 places where people bring garbage and things they don't want anymore
- 5 answered a question
- 7 sad or feeling unhappy
- 8 most of the time

DOWN

- 1 happening right away
- 2 anxious or worried that something is wrong
- 4 feeling afraid that something bad will happen
- 6 mad or unhappy

WORD BANK: concerned, depressed, dumps, immediately, replied, upset, usually, worried
