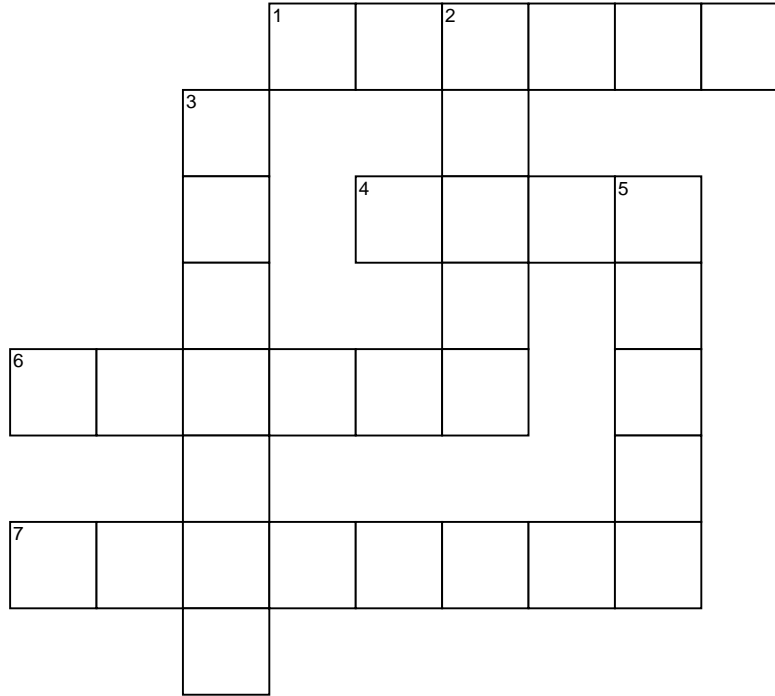


Aardvarks

- 7 small insects that eat wood

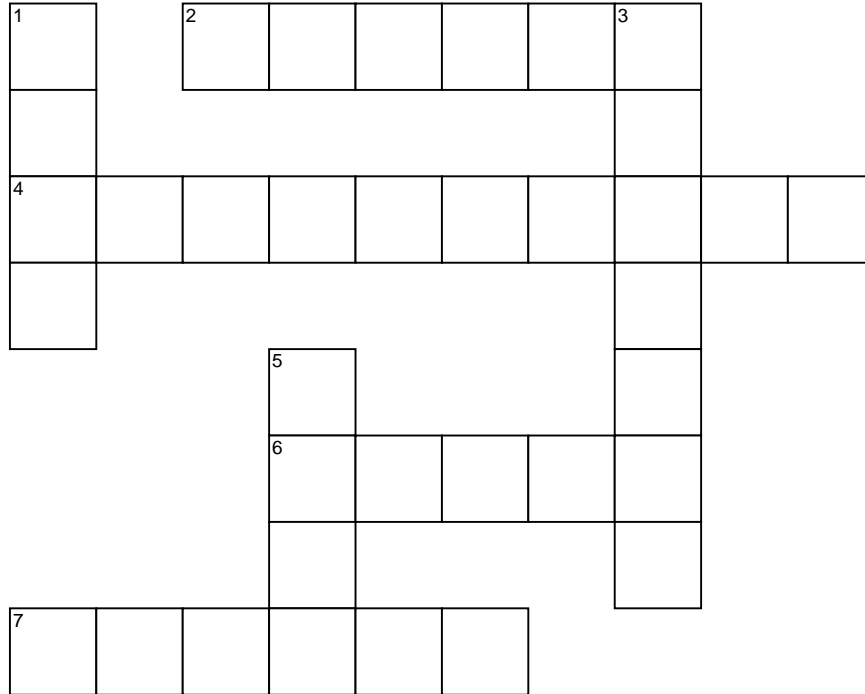
DOWN

- 7 when something is sent upward into the air

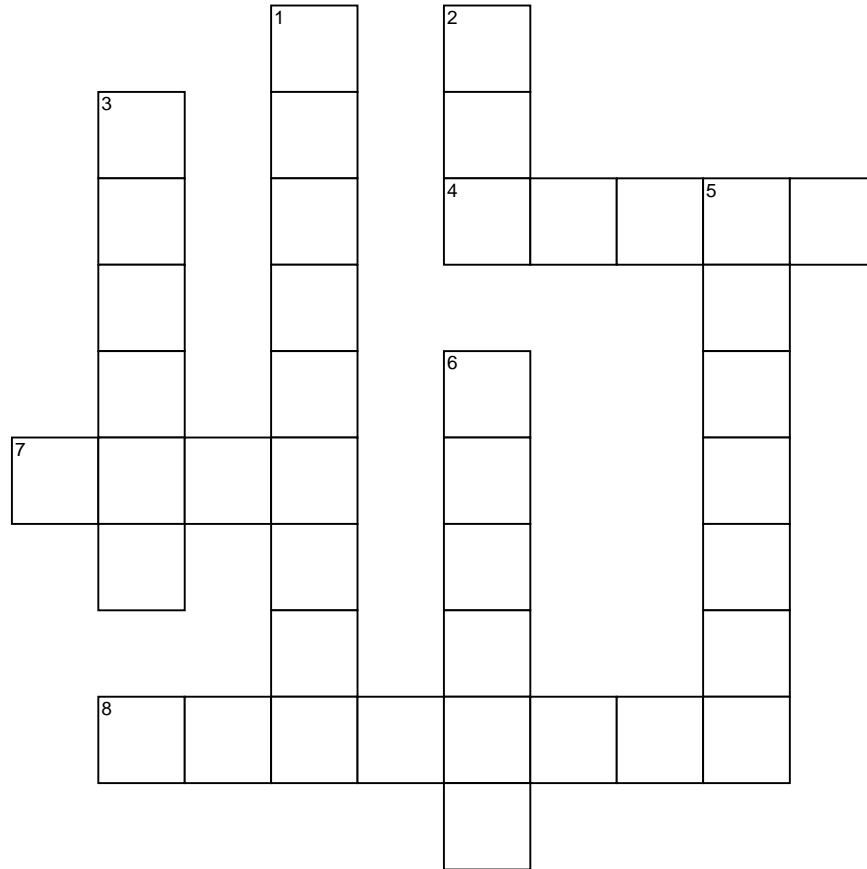
DOWN

- 8 places or things that offer protection from weather or danger

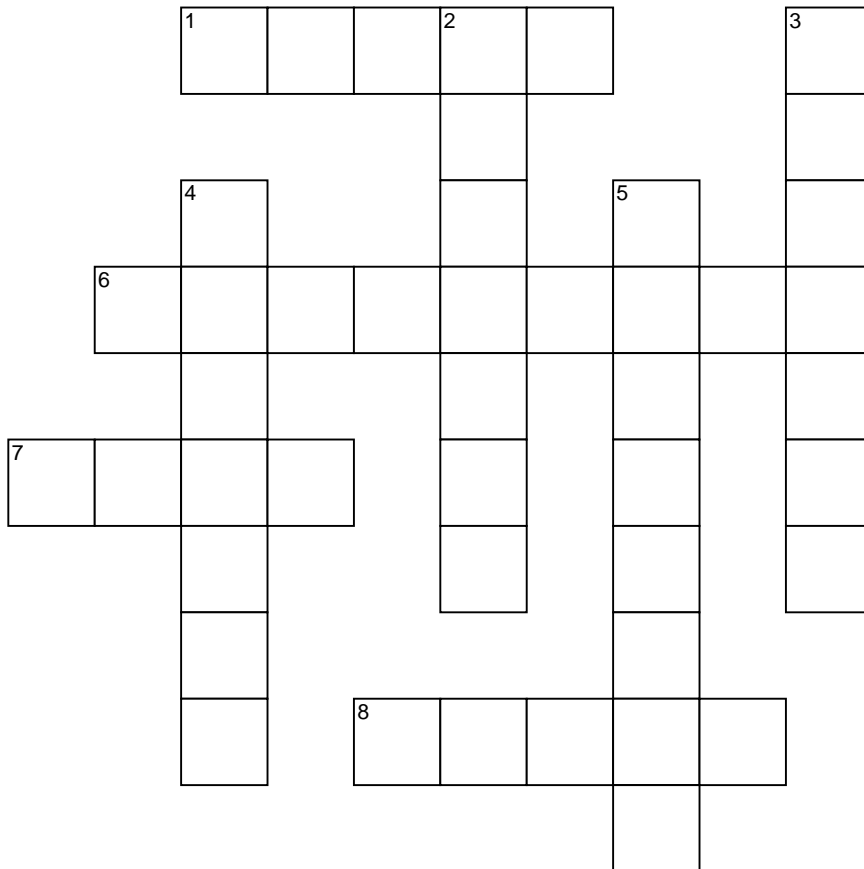
DOWN

- 8** from then until now

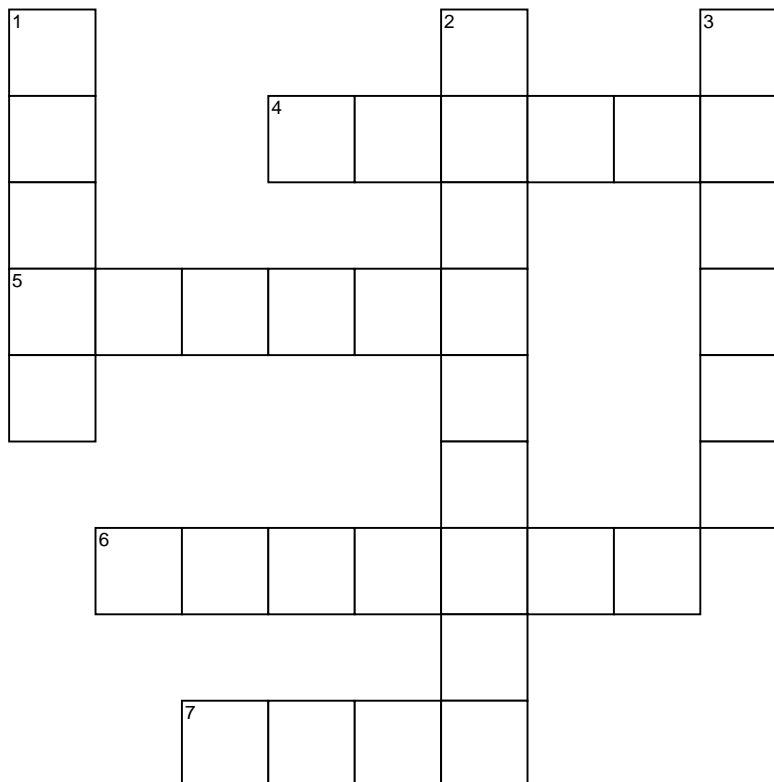
DOWN

- 7 get control of a person or place by force

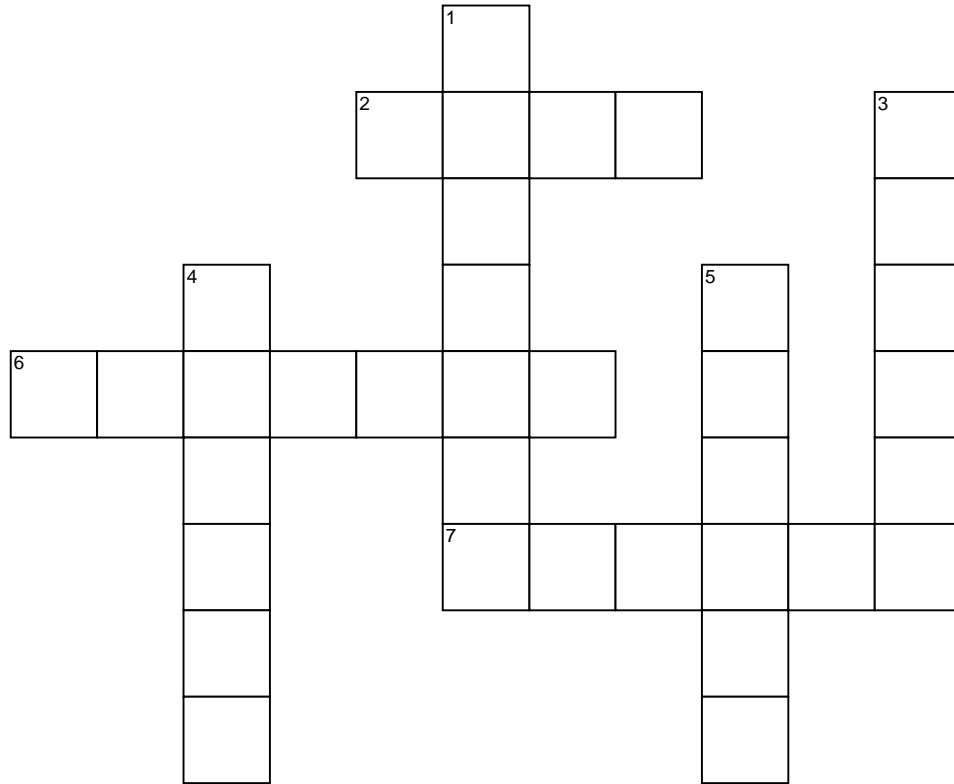
DOWN

- 7** put a lot of effort into something difficult

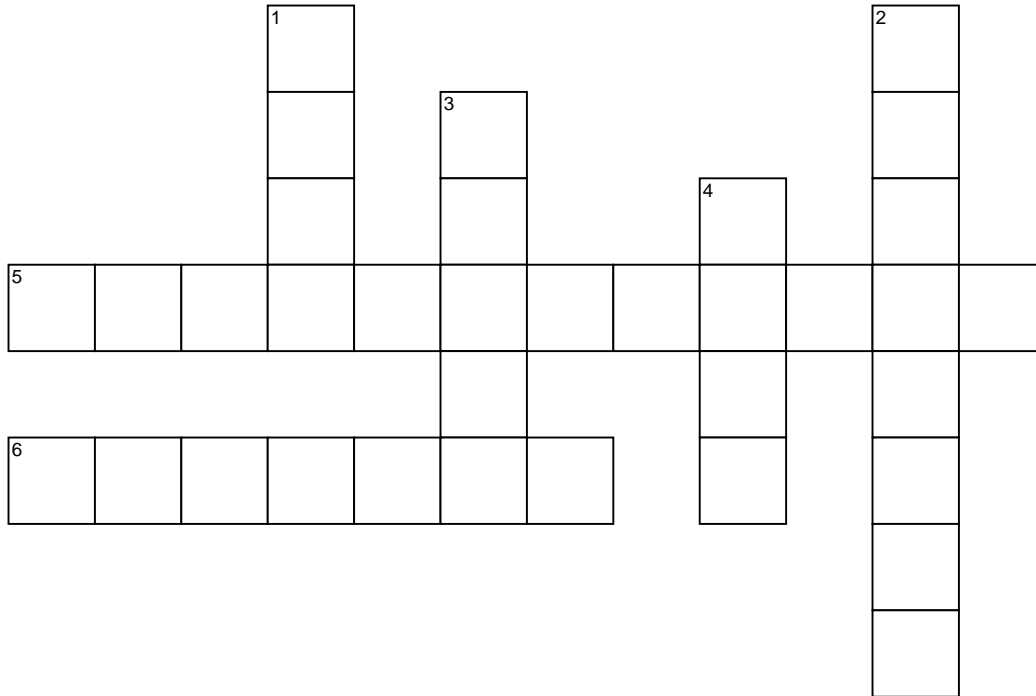
DOWN

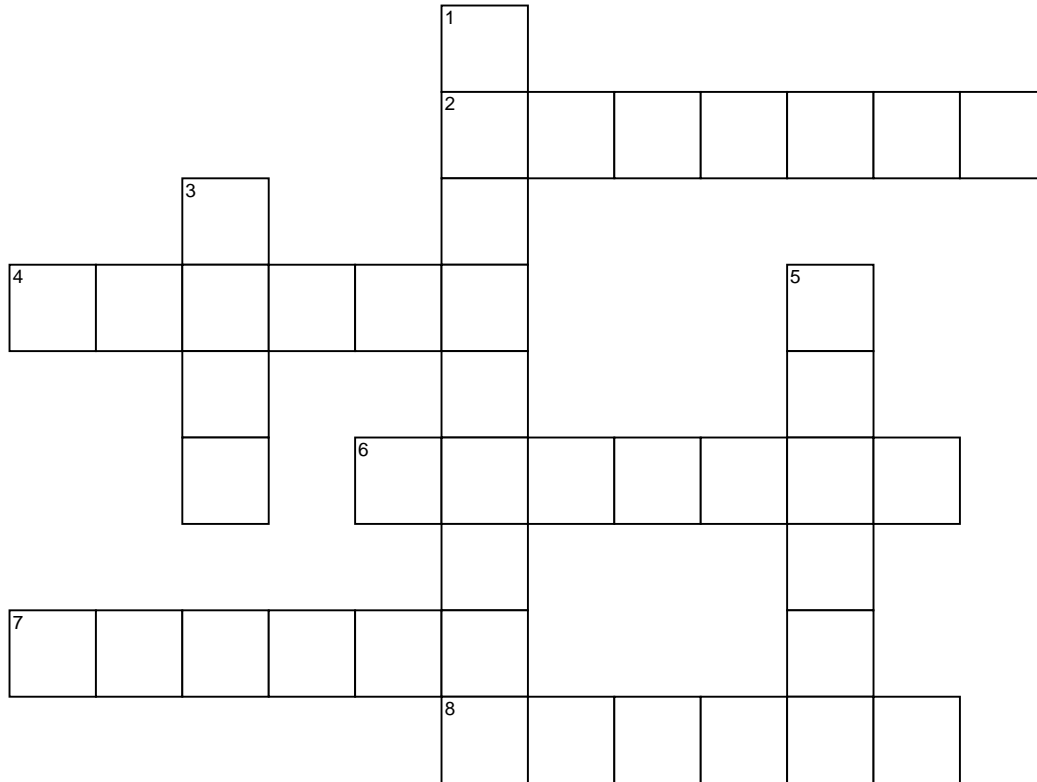

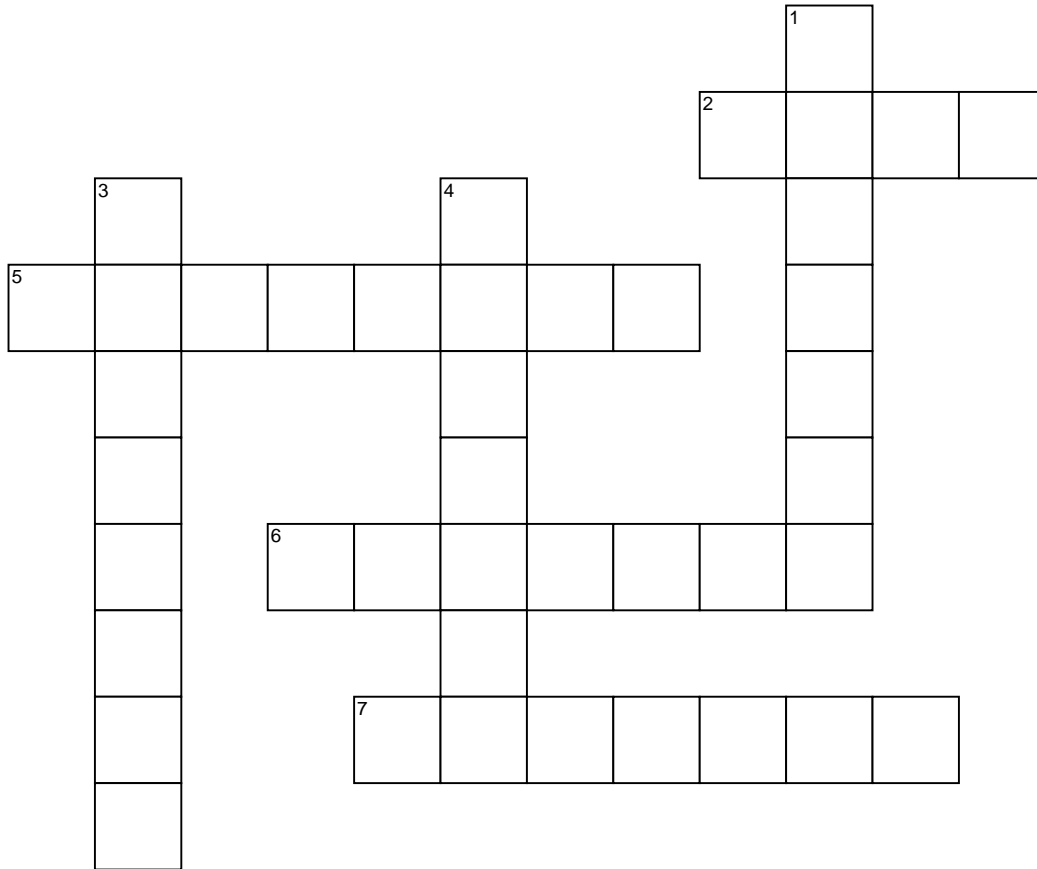

- 7** most of the time

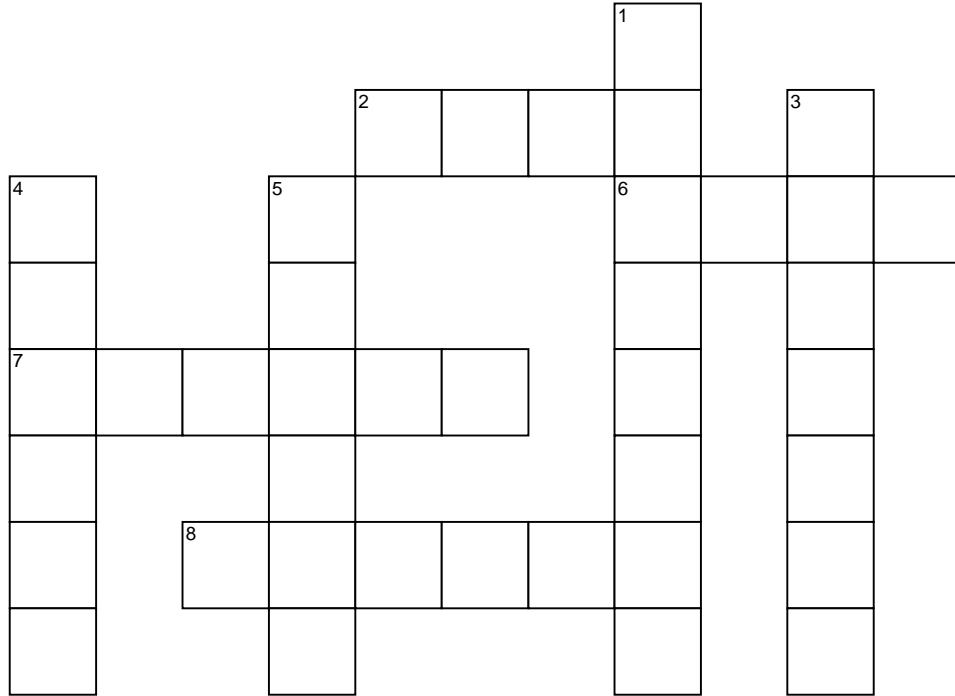
DOWN

- 8 mild or not likely to cause harm

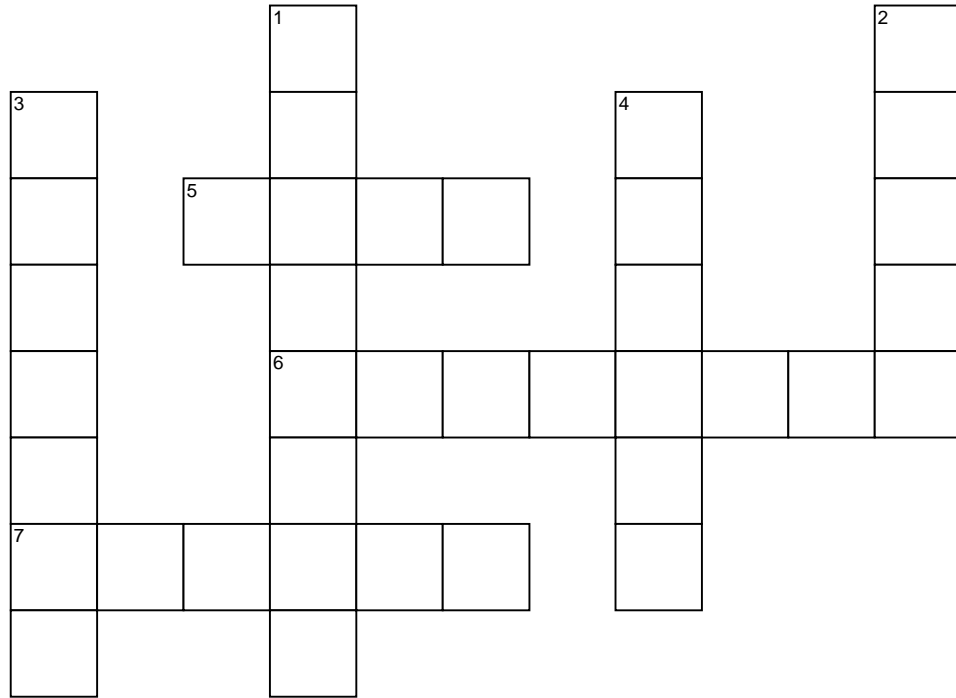
DOWN

- 7** fell down thick and fast

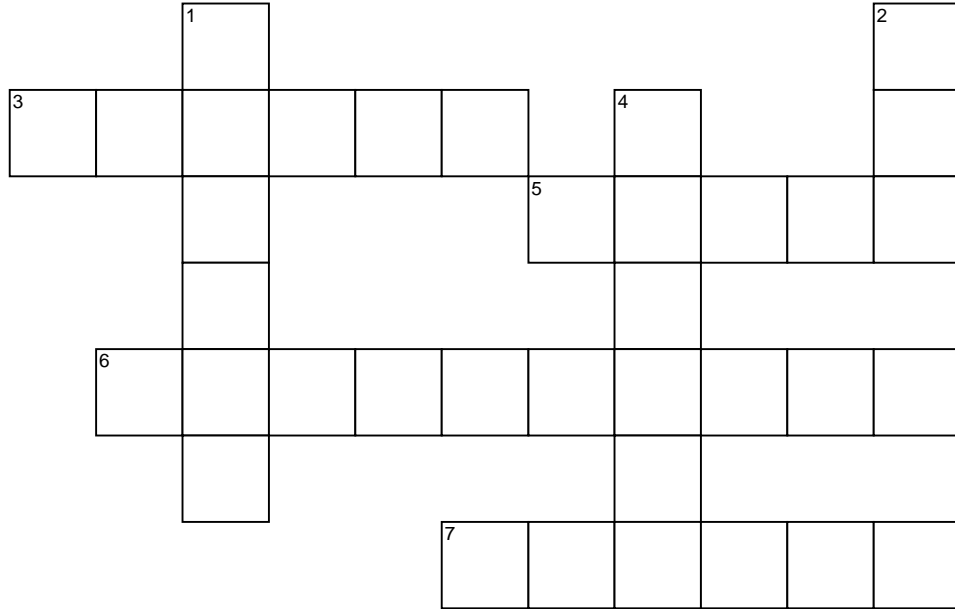
DOWN

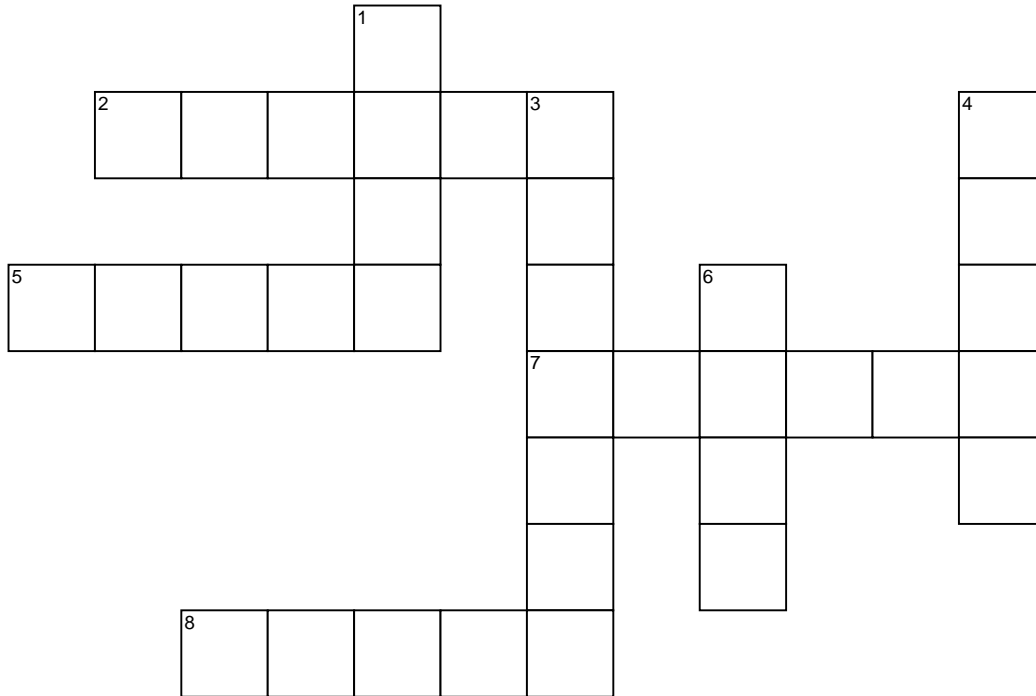

- 8 move in the shape of a circle

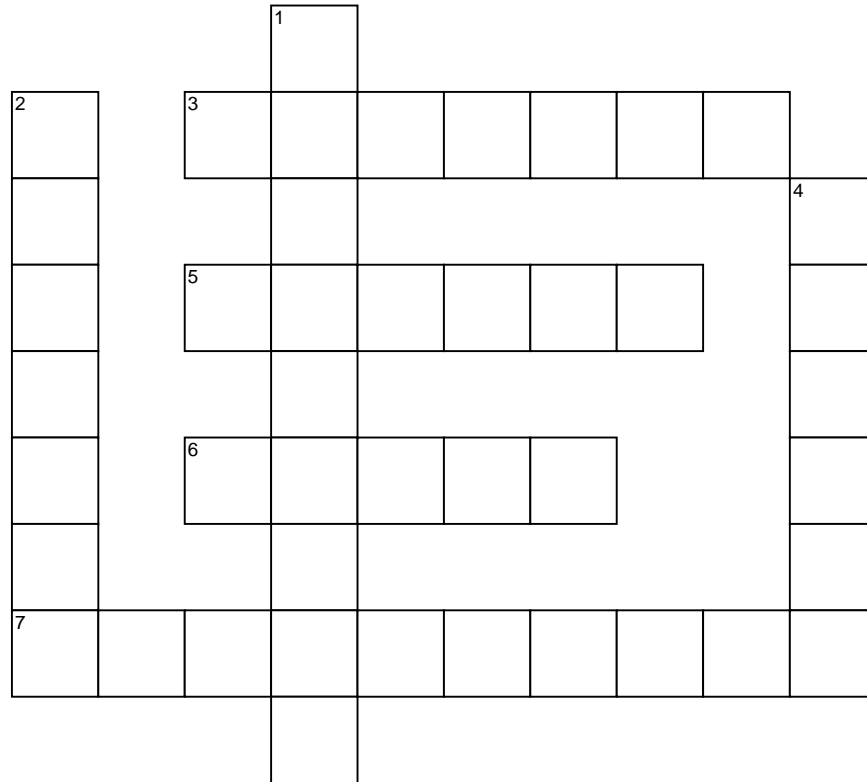

- 7** the telling of what to do, where to go, or how to do something

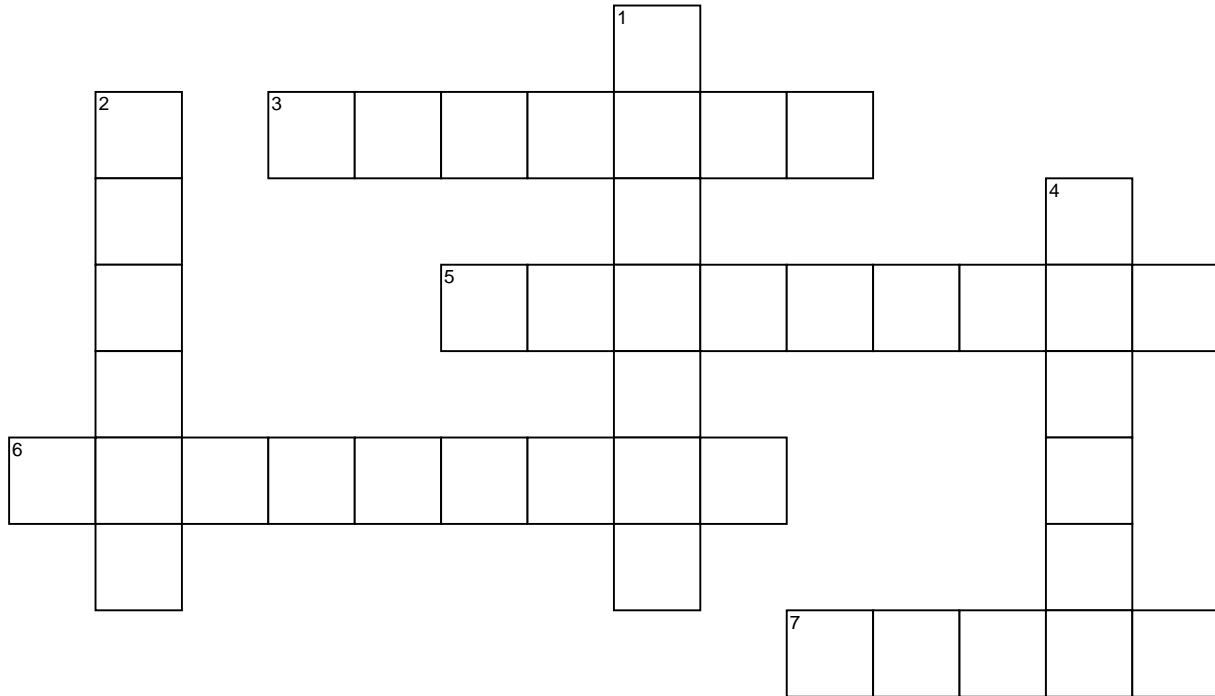
DOWN

- 7** an odd way someone has of doing something

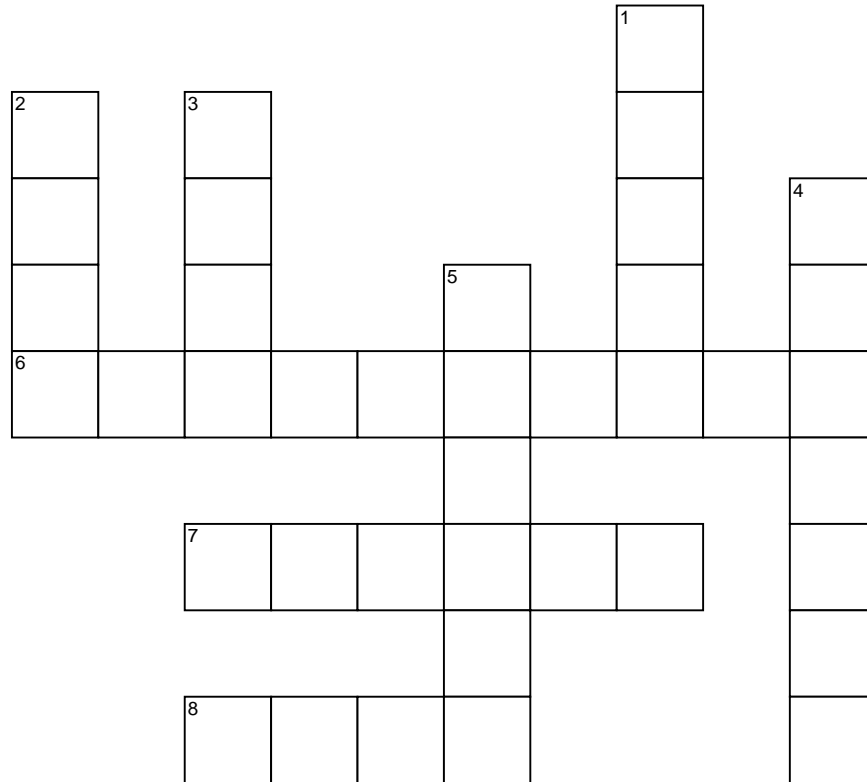
DOWN

- 8 when there is no light because the sun went down

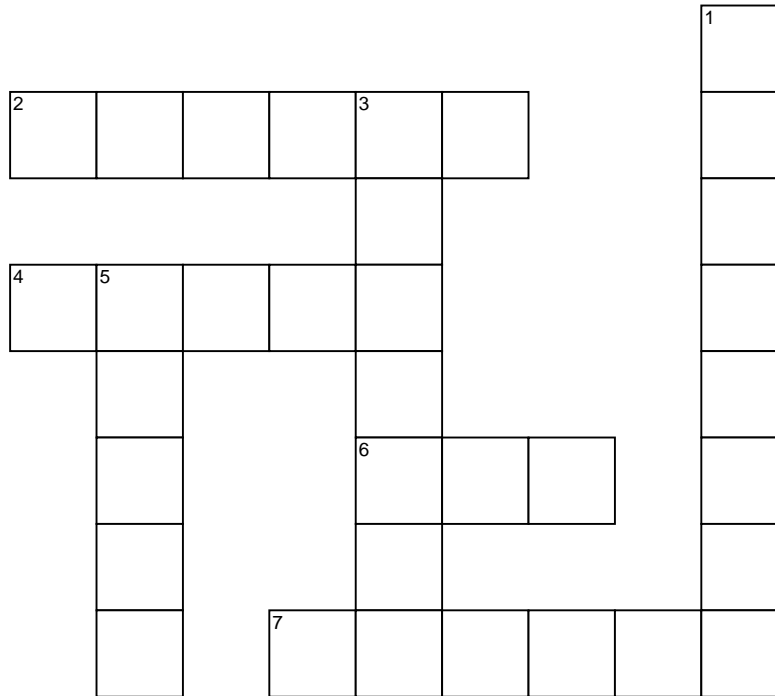
DOWN

- 7 started to exist or take shape

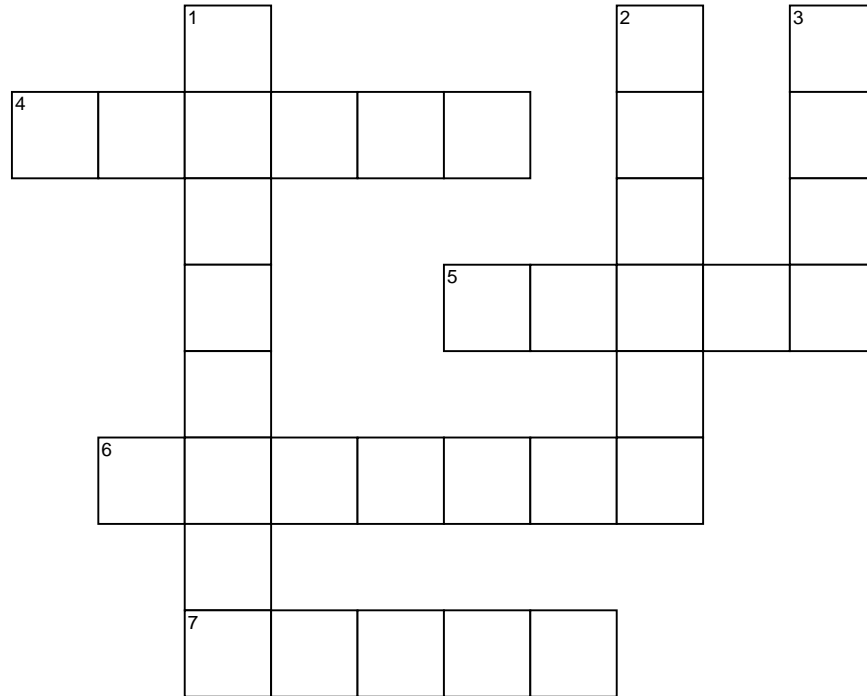
DOWN

- 7 the backbone of an animal

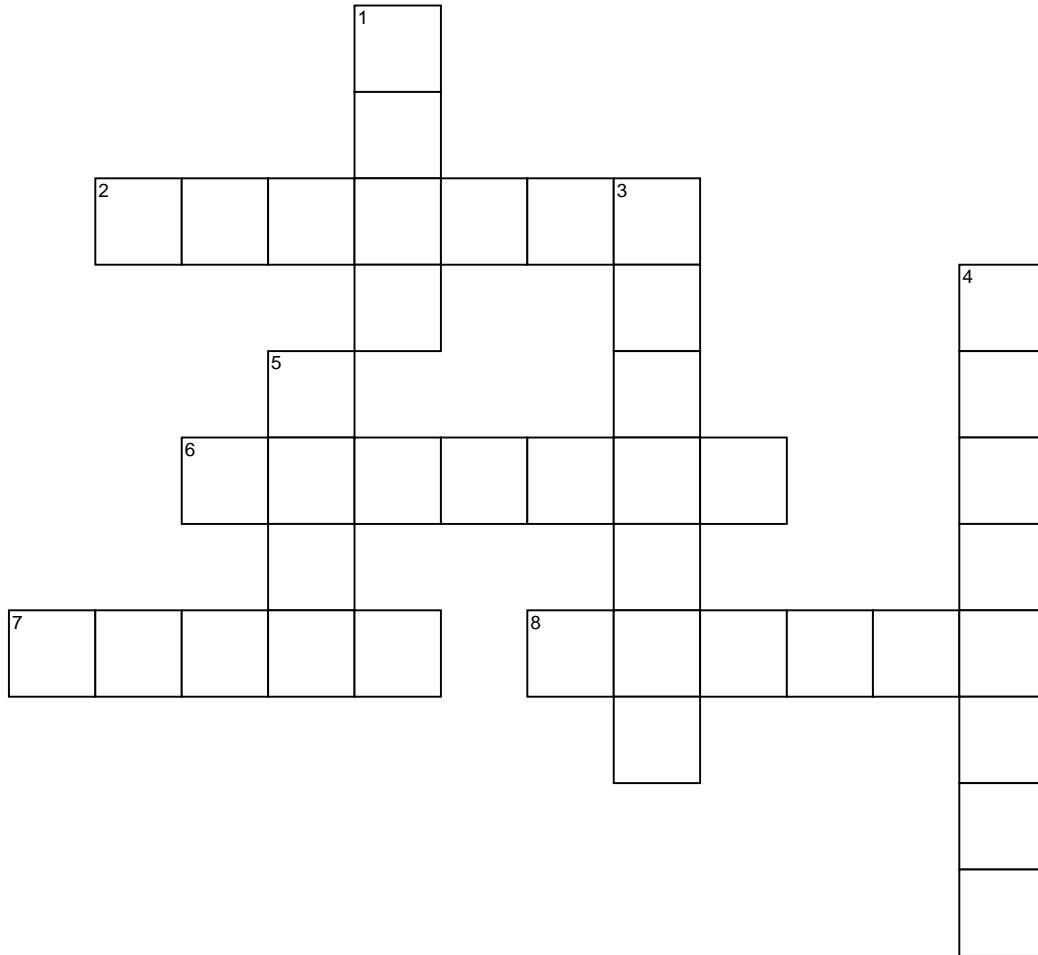
DOWN

- 8 took a quick, secret look

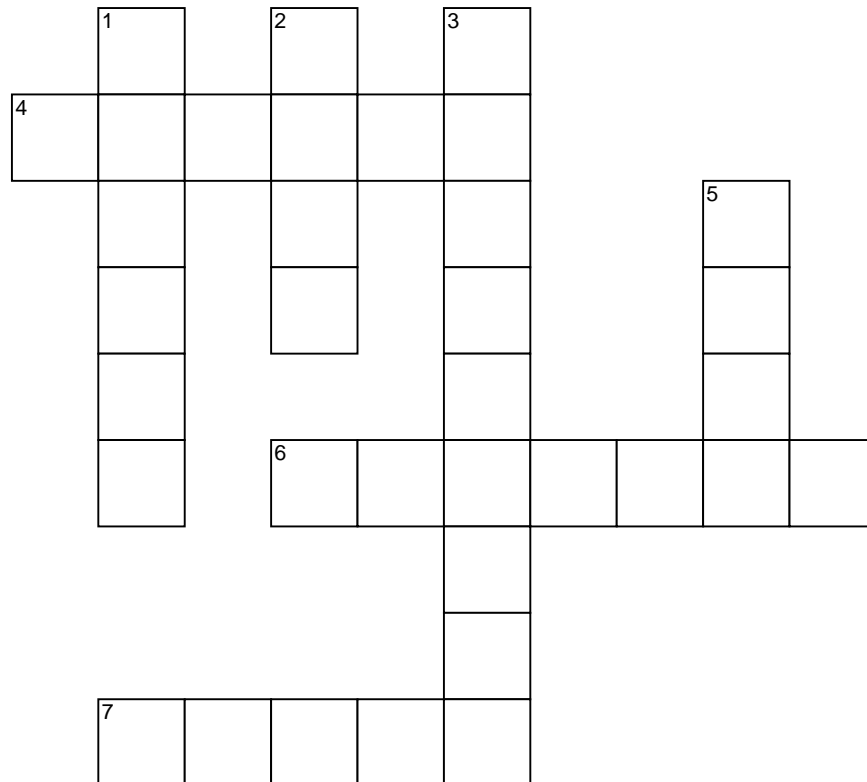
DOWN

- 7** to stay away from

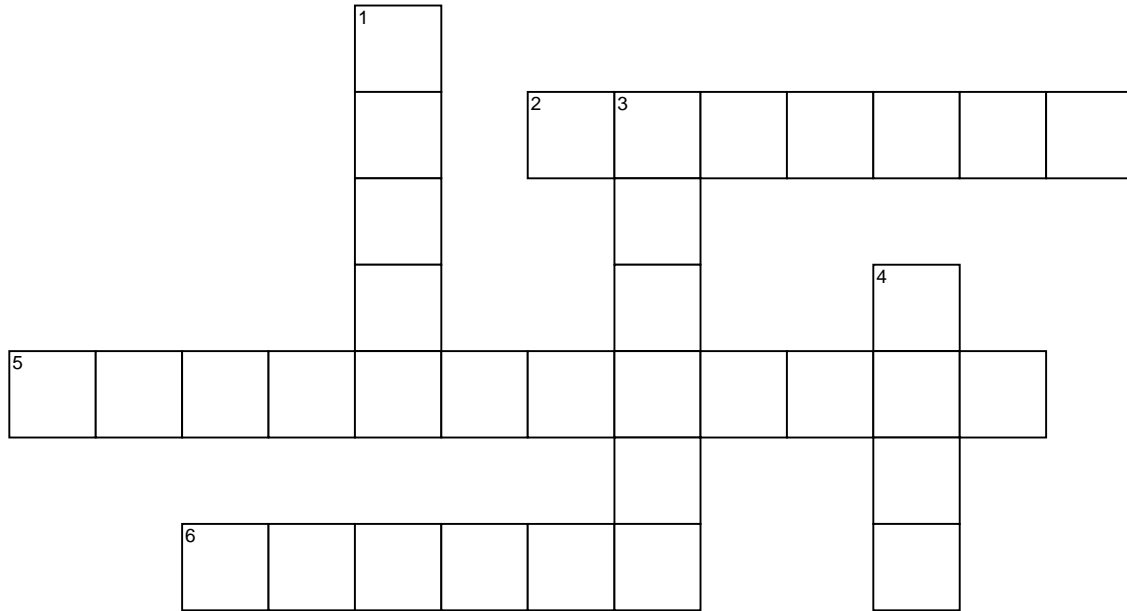
DOWN

- 6 was useful to a person or thing

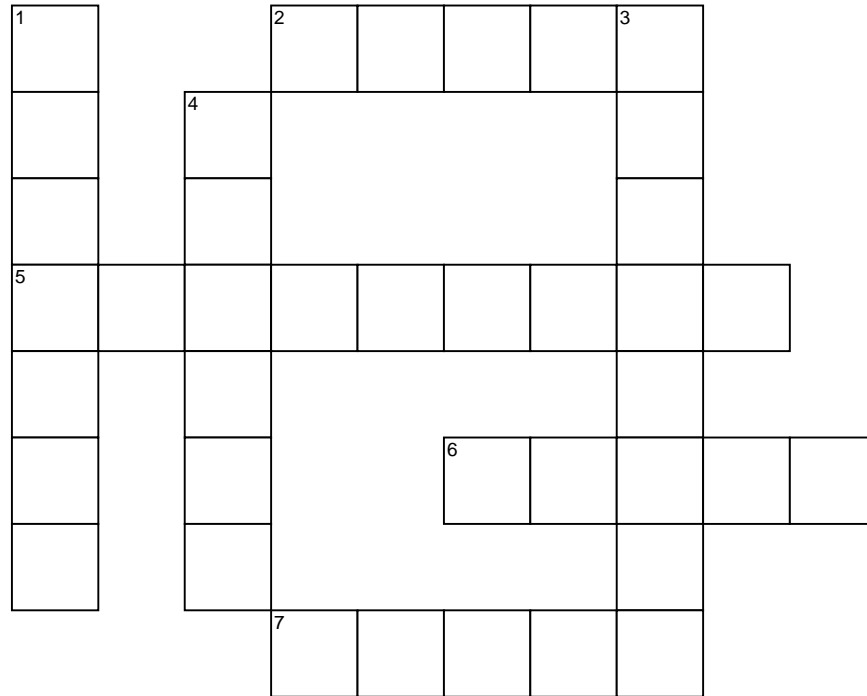
DOWN

- 7 starts to exist or take shape

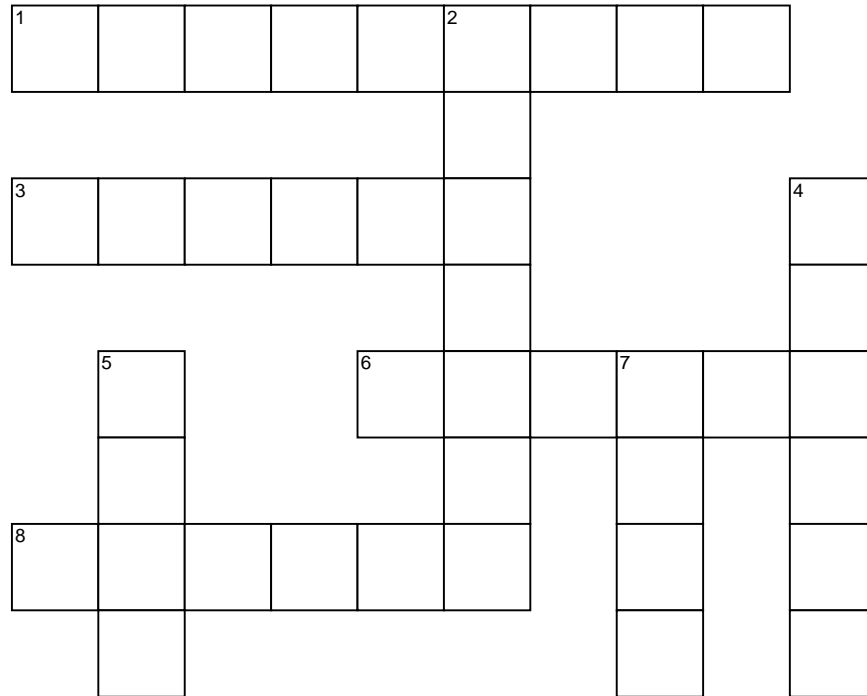
DOWN

- 8 flat spaces like shelves on the sides of cliffs

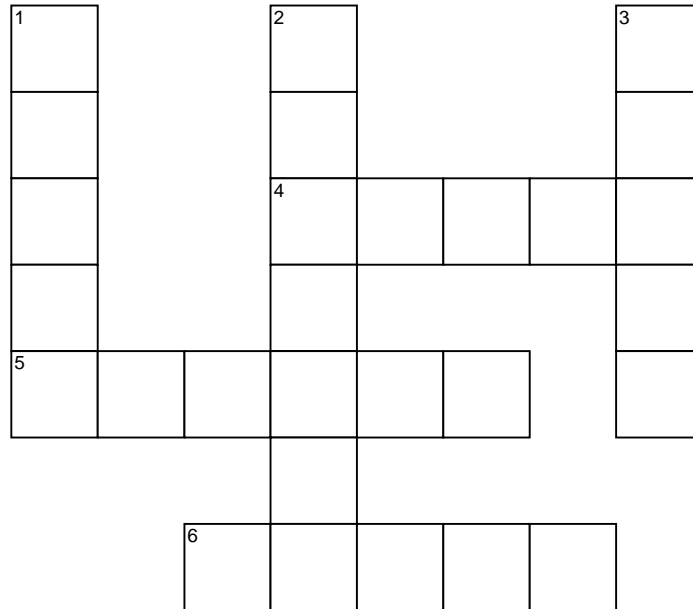
DOWN
