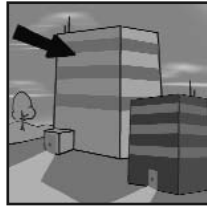

Big means large in size.

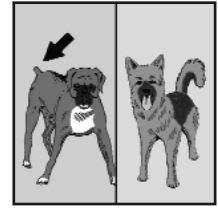
The big building took up more room than any of the smaller buildings.

Some dogs have short tails, and some have long tails.



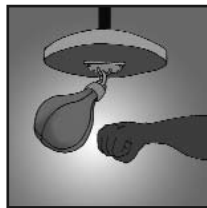

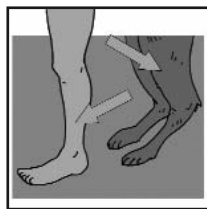

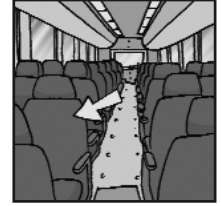

A town is a place with houses and stores where people live and work.



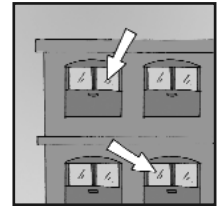

Windows are openings that let you see outside.

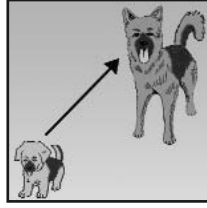

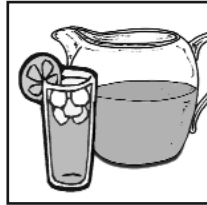

Ripe means ready to be eaten. *Green bananas are not ripe, but yellow bananas are.*

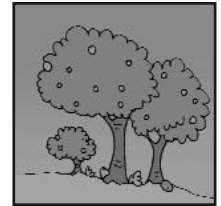

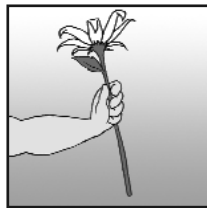
Trees are large plants with branches, leaves, and thick trunks.



pick¹⁴

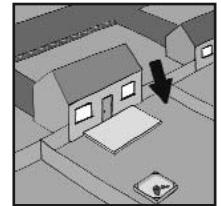
When you pick something, you take it in your hand and pull it off of something else.

A yard is the area around or next to a house or building. *I will plant flowers in my yard.*

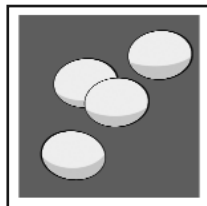

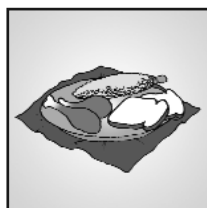
Meat is food that we get from animals.

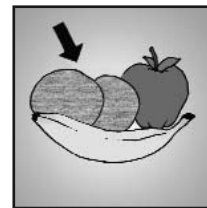

Oranges are round fruit that grow on trees.

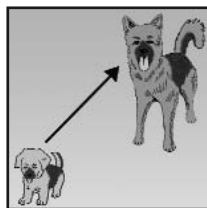
Oranges, apples, and bananas are fruits we eat.

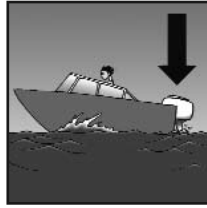
Worms are long, thin, soft animals that have no legs and no backbones.

row²⁰

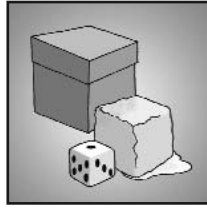
When you row, you use oars to make a boat go.

meat¹⁴

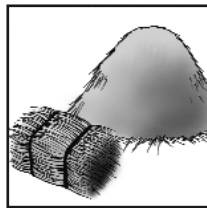
Meat is food that we get from animals.

"Moo" is a noise that a cow makes.

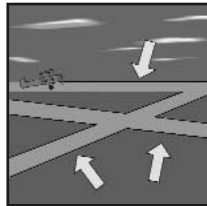

Clouds are groups of tiny drops of water that float in the sky.

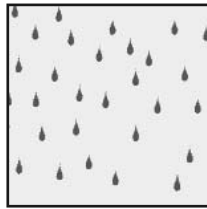

Drops are small amounts of water or other liquid.

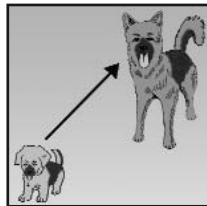
The rain falls in drops.

Busy means there are many things going on.

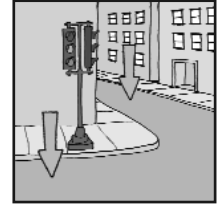

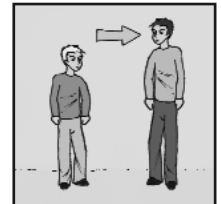

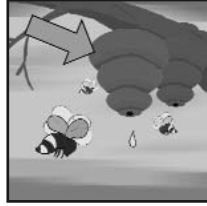

Beehives are places where bees live and make honey.



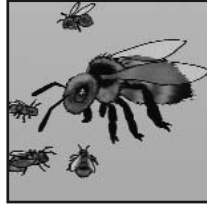

A flower is the colorful part of a plant.



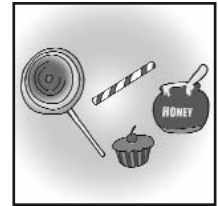

Bees are insects with wings and furry bodies.



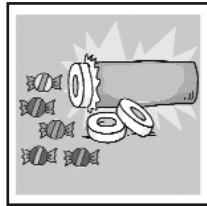
sweet¹¹

"Moo" is a noise that a cow makes.

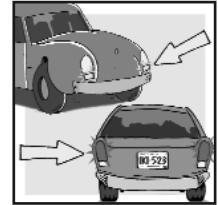

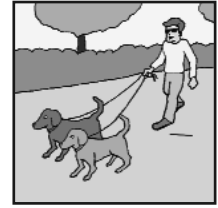

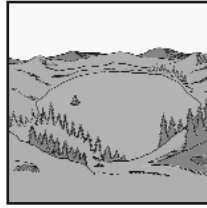

Broken means not working because of a problem.

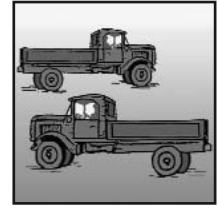
His car was broken, so he had to fix it before he could use it.

Pickup trucks are small, open trucks that people use to move light loads from one place to another.

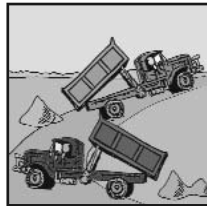
Our friends used their pickup trucks to help us move five beds.



dump trucks¹⁹

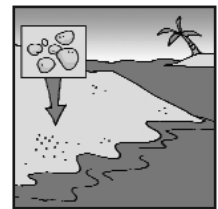
Dump trucks are trucks that people use to move big loads from one place to another.

sand²⁰

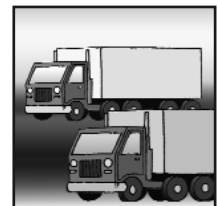
Sand is little pieces of rocks that can be found in deserts and next to lakes and oceans.

Semi trucks are big trucks with two parts. The front part has an engine, and the back part holds a load.

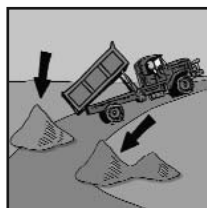
Semi trucks move things like mail, food, and gas from one place to another.
