Choosing a Level

Choose level	for students who	and who need to learn to decode and/or become fluent readers of:				
0.8	know the letters of the alphabet, have some knowledge of the letter sounds, and are able to recognize at least 15-20 written words	 short-vowel words phonetically regular, high-frequency words phonetically irregular, high-frequency words 				
1.3	read at an early to mid first- grade level	 long-vowel words phonetically regular, high-frequency words phonetically irregular, high-frequency words 				
1.8	read at a mid to late first-grade level to early second-grade level	 words with blends, digraphs, and common suffixes phonetically regular, high-frequency words phonetically irregular, high-frequency words
