






Why It Works


Independent Program


- Placement is not required.

- Program suggests content to a student but does not restrict the stories in which a student can work.

















One Minute Reader Live Levels



F	5	Middle fifth-grade reading level	Stories consist of complex text with more advanced concepts.
















































Meeting Various Needs

Scheduling Read Live Programs



Read Naturally Live (or Español)

- 30 minutes per session preferred
- 3 to 5 days (5 preferred)

Word Warm-ups Live

- 10-minute warm up, or 20 to 30-minute intervention
- 3 to 5 days (5 preferred)



- Independent reading time
- Homework
- Summer reading



Meeting Various Needs

When to use...

One Minute Reader Live is ideal for:

- Independent reading time
- Additional practice to support intervention
- Homework during the school year
- Extra practice over holiday breaks
- Structured practice over summer break


Working in Both Programs


Students who are working in Read Naturally Live as an intervention may also access One Minute Reader Live for independent practice.


- Students work in One Minute Reader Live during silent sustained reading for structured, independent reading practice.
- Students can work in One Minute Reader Live during an intervention block while waiting to be placed in Read Naturally Live.
- Students can work in One Minute Reader Live during school breaks for additional practice.


